

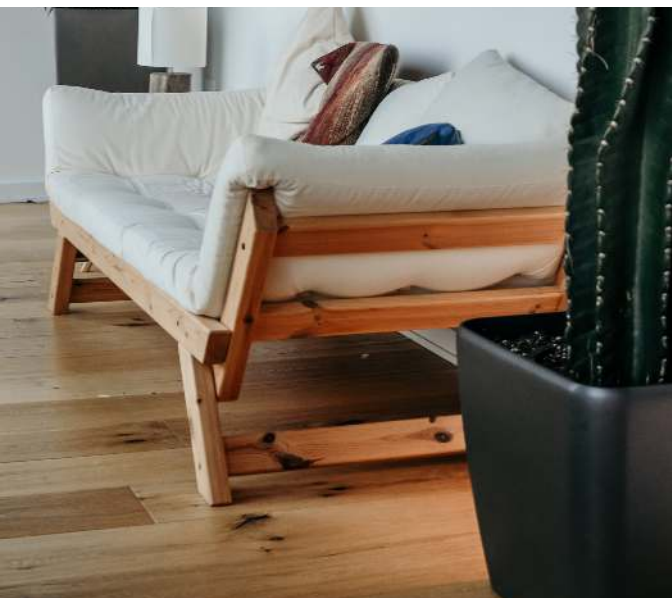

BLACKBUTT

Blackbutt is one of Australia's premium native hardwoods with a striking appearance and a high degree of natural durability and strength, making it an ideal for engineered timber flooring. The common name blackbutt came about due to the tree's appearance after bushfire, whereby the buttress - or butt - was significantly darkened. Blackbutt timber commonly available commercial hardwood species in New South Wales and southern Queensland, often used for building framework. Blackbutt engineered timber flooring is a timeless product, offering a warmth and natural beauty largely unmatched by other flooring options.

The timber flooring is manufactured with components that are FSC certified, Australia/ New Zealand sourced pine as the core material and with the Australian hardwood as the wear layer. Thus creating a product high in quality and structurally stable. The Australian Prestige comprise of the 5g Välinge Click system and enables a simple installation method.

Australian Prestige utilises a 6 layer coat of lacquer cured by UV light, which is done through highly technological machinery application thus making it more durable and highly scratch and stain resistant.
