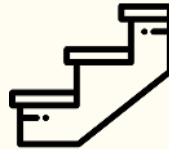


SUSTAINABILITY

The Nature's Blue Gum is native to the New South Wales land and with many part of the land commencing replantation programs to ensure the sustainability of the species. Currently there is over 5000 hectares of land that will see more than 25000 new plantation eucalyptus saplings established each year. The NSW State Forestry ensures that their forest follows the Australian Forestry Standards which is a sustainable forest management.

Nature's Blue Gum's most common applications are flooring, furniture, cladding, fencing, stairs because of its appealing and elegant grain pattern and consistency of colour throughout the range of subspecies.
