## TASMANIAN OAK

Tasmanian oak is a premium Australian hardwood timber that grow in the mountainous areas of Tasmania. It is a versatile timber perfect for both construction and interior applications, including flooring.

Tasmanian oak is light in colour, varying from straw to reddish brown with intermediate shades of cream to pink. It is recognised for its excellent staining qualities, which allow ready matching with other timbers, finishes or furnishings.

The timber flooring is manufactured with components that are FSC certified, Australia/ New Zealand sourced pine as the core material and with the Australian hardwood as the wear layer. Thus creating a product high in quality and structurally stable. The Australian Prestige comprise of the 5g Välinge Click system and enables a simple installation method.

Australian Prestige utilises a 6 layer coat of lacquer cured by UV light, which is done through highly technological machinery application thus making it more durable and highly scratch and stain resistant.

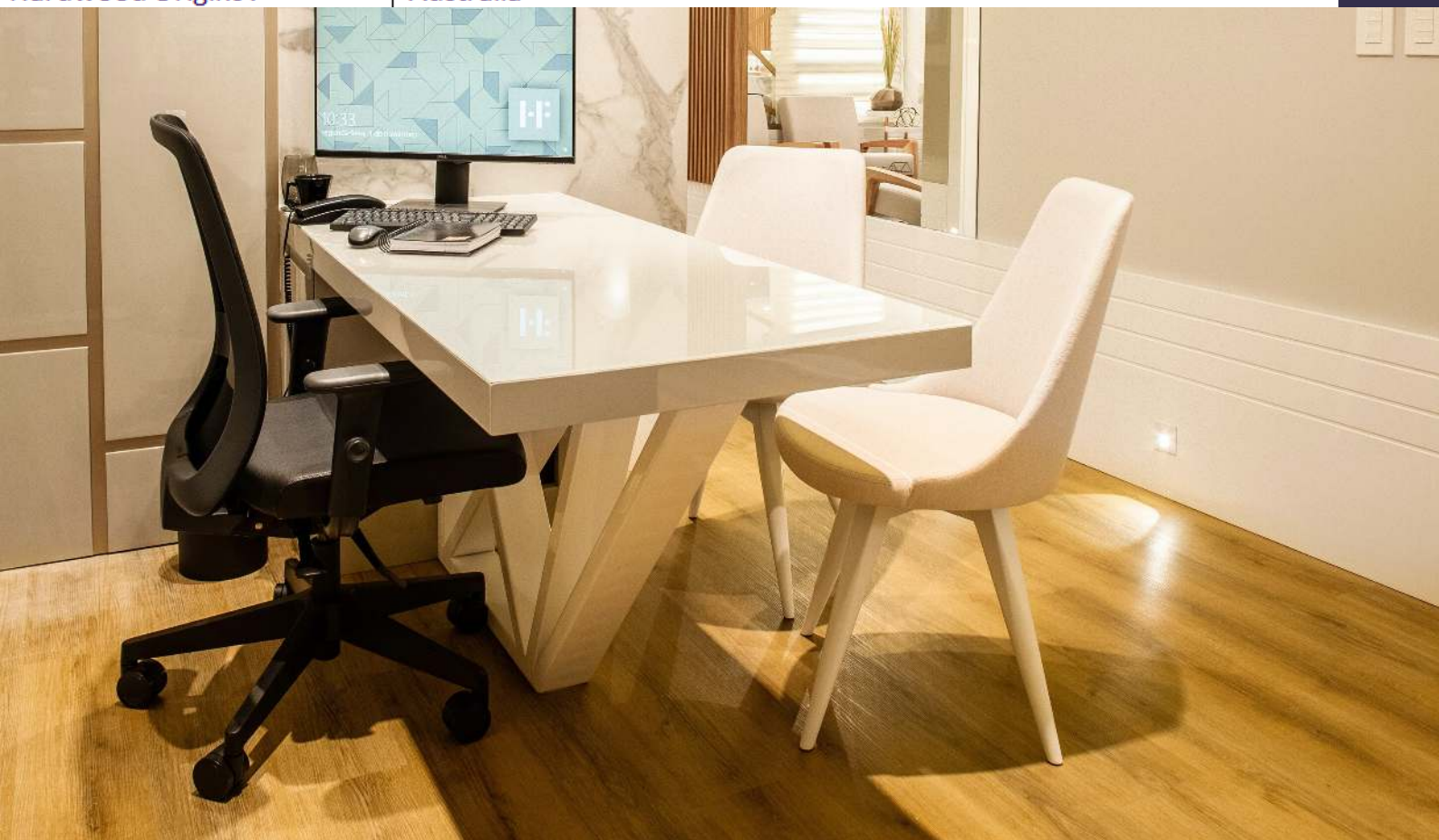
